The role of Learning Mentor enables students to work towards overcoming social, emotional and learning difficulties which act as barriers to learning. The barriers to learning can be wide ranging and often very personal to the individual pupil. Learning Mentors help to support in overcoming these issues and help them to address what it is that is getting in the way of their learning.
